CASE OF SPILL OR RELEASE: Slippery underfoot. Wear appropriate respiratory & other protective equipment. Contaminate area. Small spills may be diluted with water and neutralized with vinegar. Large spills should be diked and picked up with a commercial absorbent. Prevent discharge to ground water.
